



# **CALS/MAFES Outstanding Staff Awards**

The College of Agriculture and Life Sciences and Mississippi Agricultural and Forestry Experiment Station will recognize two outstanding staff employees at the Spring CALS/MAFES Awards Luncheon, one in the professional staff category and one in the support staff category. Winners will receive a plaque and \$1,000.

### **Eligibility**

All CALS and MAFES full-time employees who have been employed a minimum of three years are eligible.

As a CALS or MAFES employee, this person is expected to:

- 1. Exemplify professionalism and dedication to CALS, MAFES or MSU by performing beyond the call of duty to improve service, quality, and image of the department/unit,
- 2. Serve as a positive role model for other faculty, staff, and/or students,
- 3. Demonstrate outstanding accomplishments of significance based on initiative, cooperation, and ability to perform a job successfully,
- 4. Demonstrate a high degree of competence and professionalism,
- 5. Work beyond the boundaries of the job by participating in MSU campus activities or community service projects.

#### **Nomination Process**

- 1. Nominations will be accepted from MSU faculty or staff.
- 2. Nominator must complete the Nominee Information Form and attach two supporting letters. Only one Nomination Form is required per nominee.
- 3. The deadline for submitting nominations is February 22.

## **Selection Process**

A peer committee to select the awardee from the individuals nominated will be appointed by the CALS Dean/MAFES Director. The committee will be drawn from past winners.
